Types of Data Collected

Among the Personal Data collected by this Application, either independently or through third parties, are: Tracking Tools, Usage Data, device information, first name, last name, gender, date of birth, phone number, physical address, country, state, county, email address, ZIP/postal code, various types of Data, city, User ID, number of Users, session statistics, payment information, billing address, username, password, identity card, tax code, biometric data, address, financial information.

Complete details on each category of Personal Data collected are provided in the dedicated sections of this privacy policy or through specific notices displayed before the Data is collected.

Personal Data may be freely provided by the User or, in the case of Usage Data, collected automatically while using this Application.

Unless otherwise specified, all Data requested by this Application is mandatory. If the User refuses to provide it, it may be impossible for this Application to provide the Service. Where this Application specifically states that some Data is optional, Users are free not to communicate that Data without any consequences to the availability or operation of the Service.

Users who have doubts about which Data is mandatory are encouraged to contact the Controller.

Any use of Cookies - or of other tracking tools - by this Application or by the owners of third-party services used by this Application serves the purpose of providing the Service requested by the User, in addition to the further purposes described in this document and in the Cookie Policy.

The User assumes responsibility for the Personal Data of third parties obtained, published or shared through this Application.

Methods and place of processing of the collected Data

Methods of processing

The Controller adopts appropriate security measures aimed at preventing unauthorized access, disclosure, modification or destruction of Personal Data.

Processing is carried out using IT and/or telematic tools, with organizational methods and logic strictly related to the stated purposes. In addition to the Controller, in some cases other parties involved in the organization of this Application may have access to the Data (administrative, sales, marketing, legal personnel, system administrators) or external parties (such as third-party technical service providers, postal carriers, hosting providers, IT companies and communications agencies), also appointed, where necessary, as Data Processors by the Controller. The updated list of Processors may always be requested from the Controller.

Place

Data is processed at the Controller's operating offices and in any other place where the parties involved in the processing are located. For further information, please contact the Controller.

The User's Personal Data may be transferred to a country other than the one in which the User is located. To obtain further information on the place of processing, the User may refer to the section containing details on the processing of Personal Data.

Retention period

Legal basis of processing

The Controller processes Personal Data relating to the User if one of the following conditions applies:

- the User has given consent for one or more specific purposes;
- processing is necessary for the performance of a contract with the User and/or for any pre-contractual obligations thereof;
- processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject;
- processing is related to a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Controller;
- processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller or by a third party.

In any case, the Controller will gladly help clarify the specific legal basis that applies to the processing, and in particular whether the provision of Personal Data is a statutory or contractual requirement, or a requirement necessary to enter into a contract.

Further information about retention time

Unless otherwise indicated in this document, Personal Data is processed and stored for as long as required by the purpose for which it has been collected and may be retained for longer due to applicable legal obligations or based on the Users' consent.

Therefore:

- Personal Data collected for purposes related to the performance of a contract between the Controller and the User shall be retained until such contract has been fully performed.
- Personal Data collected for the purposes of the Controller's legitimate interests shall be retained as long as needed to fulfill such purposes. Users may find specific information regarding the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller within the relevant sections of this document or by contacting the Controller.

When processing is based on the User's consent, the Controller may retain Personal Data longer until such consent is withdrawn. Furthermore, the Controller may be obliged to retain Personal Data for a longer period whenever required to do so for the performance of a legal obligation or upon order of an authority.

Once the retention period expires, Personal Data shall be deleted. Therefore, the right of access, the right to erasure, the right to rectification and the right to data portability cannot be enforced after the expiration of the retention period.

The rights of Users under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Users may exercise certain rights regarding their Data processed by the Controller.

In particular, within the limits established by law, Users have the right to:

- withdraw their consent at any time. Users have the right to withdraw consent where they have previously given their consent to the processing of their Personal Data;
- object to processing of their Data. Users have the right to object to the processing of their Data if the processing is carried out on a legal basis other than consent;
- access their Data. Users have the right to learn if Data is being processed by the Controller, obtain disclosure regarding certain aspects of the processing and obtain a copy of the Data undergoing processing;
- verify and seek rectification. Users have the right to verify the accuracy of their Data and ask for it to be updated or corrected;
- restrict the processing of their Data. Users have the right, under certain circumstances, to restrict the processing of their Data. In this case, the Controller will not process their Data for any purpose other than storing it;
- have their Personal Data deleted or otherwise removed. Users have the right, under certain circumstances, to obtain the erasure of their Data from the Controller;
- receive their Data and have it transferred to another controller. Users have the right to receive their Data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and, if technically feasible, to have it transmitted to another controller without hindrance;
- lodge a complaint. Users have the right to bring a claim before their competent data protection authority or seek judicial remedy.

Users are also entitled to learn about the legal basis for Data transfers abroad, including to any international organization governed by public international law or set up by two or more countries, such as the UN, and about the security measures taken by the Controller to safeguard their Data.

Details about the right to object

Where Personal Data is processed for a public interest, in the exercise of an official authority vested in the Controller or for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller, Users may object to such processing by providing a ground related to their particular situation to justify the objection.

Users must know that, however, should their Personal Data be processed for direct marketing purposes, they can object to that processing at any time, free of charge and without providing any justification. Where the User objects to processing for direct marketing purposes, the Personal Data will no longer be processed for such purposes. To learn whether the Controller is processing Personal Data for direct marketing purposes, Users may refer to the relevant sections of this document.

How to exercise these rights

Any requests to exercise User rights can be directed to the Controller through the contact details provided in this document. Such requests are free of charge and will be answered by the Controller as early as possible and always within one month, providing Users with the information required by law. Any rectification, erasure or restriction of processing shall be communicated by the Controller to each recipient, if any, to whom the Personal Data has been disclosed unless this proves impossible or involves disproportionate effort. At the Users' request, the Controller will inform them about those recipients.

Transfer of Personal Data outside the European Union

Transfer to third countries based on consent

If this is the condition for the transfer of Data, the transfer of Personal Data from the EU to third countries takes place only where the User has explicitly consented to such transfer after having been informed of the risks due to the absence of an adequacy decision and on the appropriate safeguards adopted. In such cases, the Controller informs Users and collects their consent through this Application.

Additional information for users in Switzerland

This section applies to Users in Switzerland and, for such Users, supersedes any other possibly divergent or conflicting information contained in the privacy notice.

Your privacy rights in Brazil

You have the right to:

- obtain confirmation of the existence of processing activities regarding your personal information;
- access your personal information;
- obtain correction of incomplete, inaccurate or outdated personal information;
- obtain anonymization, blocking or deletion of unnecessary or excessive personal information, or of information processed in breach of the LGPD;
- obtain information on the possibility of granting or denying your consent and the consequences thereof;
- obtain information about the third parties with whom we share your personal information;
- obtain, upon your express request, portability of your personal information (except anonymized information) to another service or product provider, provided our commercial and industrial secrets are safeguarded;
- obtain deletion of personal information processed on the basis of your consent, unless one or more of the exceptions in article 16 LGPD applies;
- withdraw your consent at any time;
- lodge a complaint relating to your personal information with the ANPD or a consumer protection body;
- object to a processing activity in cases where the processing is not carried out in compliance with the law;
- request clear and adequate information regarding the criteria and procedures used for automated decision-making; and
- request review of decisions affecting your interests made solely on the basis of automated decision-making involving your personal information, including decisions to define your personal, professional, consumer or creditor profile, or other aspects of your personality.

You will never be discriminated against or otherwise suffer any unfavorable treatment as a result of exercising your rights.

How to submit your request

You may submit an express request to exercise your rights free of charge at any time by using the contact details provided in this document or through your legal representative.

How and when we will handle your request

We will do our best to respond to your request as soon as possible.

In any event, if we are unable to do so, we will make sure to communicate the factual or legal reasons that prevent us from promptly complying with or responding to your request. Where your personal information is not processed by us, if we are able to do so, we will indicate the individual or legal entity to whom you should address your requests.

If you decide to submit an access request or a request for confirmation of the existence of processing of personal information, please specify whether you prefer to receive your personal information in electronic or printed form.

You will also need to let us know whether you want an immediate response, in which case you will receive a simplified response, or whether you require a full disclosure.

In the latter case, we will respond within 15 days from the date of your request, providing you with all information regarding the origin of your personal information, confirmation of whether or not personal information concerning you exists, the criteria used for processing and the purposes of such processing, while safeguarding our commercial and industrial secrets.

If you decide to submit a request for rectification, deletion, anonymization or blocking of personal information, we will make sure to promptly inform the other parties with whom we have shared your personal information so that they may also comply with your request - except where such communication proves impossible or involves disproportionate effort.

Transfer of personal information outside Brazil in cases permitted by law

We may transfer your personal information outside Brazilian territory in the following cases:

- when the transfer is necessary for international legal cooperation between intelligence services, investigative bodies and criminal procedure authorities, as provided by international law instruments;
- when the transfer is necessary to protect your life or physical safety or that of third parties;
- when the transfer is authorized by the ANPD;
- when the transfer results from an obligation undertaken in the context of an international cooperation agreement;
- when the transfer is necessary for the execution of a public policy or public service;
- when the transfer is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation, performance of a contract and related pre-contractual obligations, or the regular exercise of rights in judicial, administrative or arbitration proceedings.

- the right to access Personal Information: the right to know. You have the right to request that we confirm whether or not we are processing your Personal Information and to access such Personal Information;
